In 2016, she studied Nutrition and Dietetics at the Italian Academy of Mediterranean Diet in Nicotera, Italy. In 2022, she is licensed as a Clinical Psychologist

She defended the topic of her doctorate: "Emotional and behavioral problems in children of war veterans in Kosovo" on 27.10.2018 at the Faculty of Social Sciences with the profile of Psychology - Pedagogy at the European University of Tirana.

In 2014 she worked as a senior official for Monitoring and Evaluation at the Ministry of Health and from 2015 she held several positions as Dean of the Faculty "Of Care and Welfare for Children", Pro-Rector at Fama College, Coordinator at the "Italian Academy of Nutrition" in Pristina.

In June 2022, she was elected with the rank of Assistant Professor. She worked as a lecturer-professor in several universities and colleges, inside and outside the country, and she currently works as a university professor. She has participated in over 70 papers in international and national scientific conferences and over 25 publications in scientific journals.
